THE PROJECT ACTIVITIES WILL CONTRIBUTE TO:

- ▶ The capacity building of the Civil Society Organizations in the country, in order to develop a constructive dialogue and long-term partnerships with Public Authorities, to develop innovative social services at the community level, sustainable and adjusted to the needs of children from vulnerable groups and of people with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities.
- ▶ The advancement of the deinstitutionalization and social inclusion reform for children from vulnerable groups and people with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities.
- ▶ The increase of the degree of accountability of the central and local Public Authorities for the promotion of the living in communities, the creation of the inclusive community environment, as well as the development and provision of quality social services at the community level.
- ▶ The Project envisages the organization of a Grants' Call, in a total sum of EURO 1,5 million, for the development and implementation of innovative social services at the community level, designated for children from vulnerable groups and people with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities.

The Goal of the Project

To empower civil society organizations in the development and implementation of innovative solutions, which envisage the promotion of the social inclusion of children from vulnerable groups and people with intellectual and psycho-social disabilities, in partnership with the public authorities.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- ▶ To facilitate the dialogue and build partnerships between the Civil Society Organizations and central and local Public Authorities, in order to develop sustainable social services at the community level.
- ▶ To build the capacities of 60 Civil Society Organizations, active in the social area, for the development and implementation of the innovative social services at the community level, designated for children from vulnerable groups and people with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities.
- ▶ To provide technical and financial assistance to the grassroots Civil Society Organizations, in the development of innovative social services at the community level, in partnership with Public Authorities.
- ▶ To build the capacities of the Civil Society Organizations, from the Alliance of Organizations for the Persons with Disabilities from the Republic of Moldova and Alliance of Active NGOs in the field of Child and Family Social Protection, in the area of monitoring and evaluation of the public property and social services at the community level.



Target-groups

- ▶ Grassroots Civil Society Organizations
- ▶ Local and central Public Authorities
- ▶ Children from vulnerable groups and their families
- ▶ People with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities

Expected results

- ▶ 60 Civil Society Organizations have built their capacity, in the building of partnership with Public Authorities and in the Development of Projects, for the setting-up of social services at the community level.
- ▶ Sustainable partnerships, built among Civil Society Organizations and central and local Public Authorities.
- ▶ 30 Civil Society Organizations, in partnership with the authorities, have developed and implemented sustainable and innovative social services at the community level, following the support and grants provided within the Project activities.
- ▶ The Alliance of Organizations for the Persons with Disabilities from the Republic of Moldova and the Alliance of Active NGOs in the field of Child and Family Social Protection are monitoring the degree of social accountability, of the local and central Public Authorities, in the provision of quality community social services, based on the needs of children from vulnerable groups and people with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities.
- ▶ Circa 1000 children from vulnerable groups and people with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities enjoy social services, developed in their communities.
- ▶ Approximately 100 children and adults with intellectual and psychosocial disabilities are deinstitutionalized and are enjoying proper support, adjusted to their needs, in their communities.
